### Article to amend Lodge By-Laws and return to original By-Laws wording.

By-Laws currently stated under Article X: Section B: Fees and dues

(b) All Lodge dues hereafter specified shall be payable annually, in advance, on or before April 1st of each year.

By-Laws Section B shall be deleted and Section A will be included to now read:

(a) semi-annually, in advance, on the first days of April and October in each year, unless the Member chooses to pay the full year's Lodge dues on or before April 1st;
