
Hello Brothers and Sisters:

Here we are at the beginning of a new year and a new lease on life. If you are reading this then the Mayans were wrong and the world didn't end on December 21st - a new invigoration! Winter may have just started but it feels like it is already past its zenith.

I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas and a safe New Year's Eve. Soon we will be putting the lights and ornaments away for another year, but let's keep the Spirit of Christmas in our hearts and minds for the entire year ahead.

Now I would like to talk about the proposed Bylaw changes on our yearly dues. The first proposal is to increase regular member dues from \$120 to \$150 per year which would raise an additional \$10,000 for the Lodge. This is only \$2.50 more a month, the price of a beer. Couldn't we all afford to contribute that much to our Lodge?

The second proposal would raise our Life Membership dues from \$25 to half the regular members' dues. If we remain at \$120 than that would increase their dues to



\$60 (\$35 increase) or if \$150 to \$75 (\$50 increase). If we raise the dues to \$60 that would raise our revenue an additional \$3745.00, if raised to \$75 than it would increase it by \$5035.00. This plus increasing the regular membership dues would be a big step in getting us from being in the red to the black. If this proposal does not pass than the potential loss of revenue from those 57 members eligible for Life Member would be \$5500.00 a year. That would just put us farther and farther into the red. After the Memorial Service on December 4th, I talked to some of our older members, those already Life Members or eligible to become a Life Member and the consensus was this is a fair proposal and a needed one. Is \$35 or even \$50 that much of a hardship, I don't know; only you the membership can answer this question.

As for the third proposal, I think this should only be considered if the first two fail to pass. Maybe we should table it till after the vote on proposal 1&2.

These proposals will be discussed and voted on during our next meeting on January 15th. Please, all members come to this meeting. This is an important decision which affects all of us and your vote is important.

It is my sad duty to inform you that we lost another brother. Keith Holcomb passed away on December 6th. May we keep his memory always in our hearts.

Don't forget the Elks National Foundation! It is a great investment in our Order and our Lodge. Always remember and practice Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity.

SECRETARY NOTES – JANUARY 2013

Happy New Year – it is hard to believe 2012 is over. From January to April 1, we have important business in preparation for the new lodge year. Thanks to all of the members who have supported Lodge 804 and the great Order of Elks in 2012. The Board of Directors are busy working on the budget for 2013-2014 and it will be presented at a lodge meeting in March. Be sure and attend lodge meetings – the lodge floor is where decisions are made and voted on. We are looking at an increase in our dues and the vote will take place on Tuesday, January 15th. Details of this proposal were presented at the November 20th Lodge Meeting and sent to you in December. Copies of the proposal are also posted in the lodge.

In February officers for 2013-2014 will be nominated and elected. Installation of the 2013-2014 officers will take place in late March. Watch the Echo for more information. If you would like to be an officer contact Chris Smith – Esteemed Leading Knight. Being an officer is a commitment, but also very fulfilling and an excellent way to meet new people and participate in shaping the future of our lodge. Membership due notices will be sent out in late February and payment is expected by April 1. If you cannot pay the entire amount we will accept half year's dues plus the Grand Lodge and State assessment of \$18.50 (assessment to Grand Lodge was increased to \$16.00, but the State assessment of \$2.50 did not change). The remainder of your payment is due on October 1st. The lodge is required by Statutes to pay our assessment to State and Grand Lodge by June 1st so we cannot defer this portion of your payment. Membership is the key to our organization. It allows us to continue with our charitable work as well as maintain our beautiful lodge. Help your lodge by paying your dues promptly and participating in lodge and charitable events.


