From The Station of the Loyal Knight

Greeting Members,

As we approach the Summer Solstice, my hope is that everyone has been enjoying the spring weather and been able to plant their gardens so they might enjoy a nice harvest of home grown fruits and vegetables this year.

June is perhaps one of my favorite months in Elkdom. It is the month we celebrate the birth of our Nation's flag on June 14th. At the Grand Lodge session in 1907, members resolved that June 14 of each year be declared Flag Day. Then four years later, it became a Grand Lodge statute that each lodge in the Order would hold a mandatory observance of this day in the respective lodges. This tradition continues to this day.

The Elks also played a huge role in making this a national U.S. celebration. In 1916, at the urging of the BPO Elks, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation recognizing the BPOE observance of this day for its Patriotic Expression. Then on August 3, 1949, President Harry Truman signed an Act of Congress designating June 14th of each year as National Flag Day.

A lesser known figure instrumental in establishing Flag Day was an American Patriot named Bernard J. CiGrand. He held the first recognized observance of Flag Day at Stony Hill School in Waubeka, Wisconsin. On the 3rd Saturday in June, 1894, in Chicago, he organized a celebration of the flag with public school children. This event took place at five separate parks in the city and more than 300,000 children participated. The event enjoyed the same success the following year. CiGrand is often referred to as the "Father of Flag Day." According to the Chicago Tribune, CiGrand almost "singlehandedly" created the celebration of this holiday.

I wish everyone a fabulous June and hope to see you at the Lodge!

Greetings Brother and Sister Elks,

If you have not attended our Flag Day Ceremony in the past, I encourage you to attend this year. The ceremony, to be held on June 14th, is very touching and inspiring and it is a significant part of our Elk heritage.

For those new to the Elk's or unfamiliar with Flag Day, a brief history follows. Our nation's flag was adopted by the Continental Congress on June 14th, 1777. In the late 1800's several efforts were put forth to recognize the day that marks the birth of our nation's flag. One hundred and ten years ago, in 1907, the Elk's Grand Lodge designated June 14th as Flag Day. In 1911, Grand Lodge approved the mandatory observation of Flag Day by all lodges. In 1916, with the prompting of the Elks, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation officially establishing June 14th as Flag Day. It wasn't until 1949 that Flag Day was established as an Act of Congress.

As you can see, the flag holds significance for our Order. As new members, we are told to hold the emblem of our flag first in our hearts as loyal Americans. That should stimulate us in our duty to preserve and defend all that our flag represents. Per the rules of our Order, we are distinctly American and, in being so, the success of our Order is dependent on the success of our Nation. This becomes a very powerful charge for our Order to ensure that we, as Elks, perpetually strive to ensure the survival and flourishing of our Nation. We can do so by adhering to the Golden Rule and practicing our cardinal virtues of Charity, Justice, Brotherly Love and Fidelity.

I look forward to seeing you on Flag Day.

Load Your Card Before You Load Your Grocery Cart

A great big thank you to all of our members who have continued to use their King Soopers and Albertsons/Safeway gift cards. In the past six weeks, we have received a check from Albertsons/Safeway for \$287.00 and one from King Soopers for \$305.77. That's 5% of the amount that our members spent on groceries, prescriptions, and fuel when they used their gift cards.

I may be wrong, but I'm pretty sure our members bought more than \$11,000 in groceries in the past six weeks. I believe at least fifty members have purchased cards since we started this program. If each of those members spent \$50 per week on groceries and fuel that would come to\$15,000 in six weeks and, if every member used the card, our rebate on that amount would be \$750. For some of our members \$50 a week might be close to what they spend. Others are laughing and wishing it were so. I believe, however, #804 is not getting the full benefit of this program, because some members are just not remembering to use their card. It's so easy, and the money we earn in rebates is a great way to support our Lodge financially. So please load up and use your card when you shop.


