From The Station of the Leading Knight

Greetings Sister and Brother Elks,

As I enter my first month as Esteemed Leading Knight, I feel it would be appropriate to speak to the virtue of Charity. More specifically, I would like to give a brief overview of the Elks National Foundation (ENF).

It was not until I attended a course at the State Quarterly Meeting, that I fully understood what ENF was and how important it is to the BPOE. The ENF was started in 1928 by John F. Malley, who was National President at the time. Malley's vision was to "unite the forces of the Order into a mighty army for the service of mankind." The proposal to form the ENF was voted on at Grand Lodge that year and a grant of \$100,000 was awarded.

Over the past 90 years, the ENF has contributed over \$450 million dollars to charitable projects, with the mission to help Elks build stronger communities by investing in the communities where Elks live. Funding for the ENF comes from lodges and also individual donors. When funding goals are met, lodges then have access to grants awarded by ENF. By funding the ENF, many lodges have the ability to financially generate more charitable funds than were contributed to by their particular lodge.

This year alone, ENF has set aside \$12.5 million to fund the Community Investments Programs. This program includes the money that the lodges received in honor of the 150th anniversary of the Elks. The purpose of the 150th anniversary grant is to provided services targeted to our community's needs while showcasing the local lodges to the communities in which we all reside.

In addition to the Community Investment Program, the ENF also contributes to state grants, scholarship programs, veteran's service programs, drug awareness programs, memorial maintenance, along with the Elks Hoop Shoot Free Throw contest.


