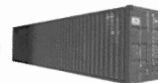



The Super Bowl pool is up and ready for action. If you'd like to buy a square see Mike Sutton before it is sold out. Squares are \$100 each. The payout will be \$1000 for quarters 1, 2 and 3 and \$2000 for the final score. In addition, the 'neighbors' of the winning squares will payout as well. \$50 for top, bottom, left, right and the 4 corners. The board 'wraps' so every square has 8 neighbors.
